- We are also praying for growth which we are experiencing in small steps.

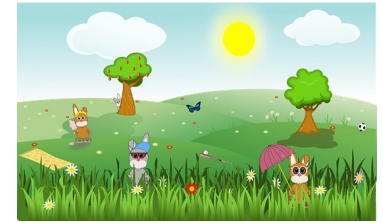
