God Revealed in Nature (following Cafe Church)

- 1. Read Hebrews 3:4 and Psalm 19:1-4. The film talks about the Creator's fingerprint being seen in creation, the work of the Builder evident in what he has built. To what extent have you witnessed this? Can you share a time when you have seen or experienced God in nature?
- 2. Psalm 139:13-14 says: For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. We too are God's creation- we are the work of His hands and our very existence testifies to our Maker! Take a moment to ponder this. Consider yourself and those around you- we proclaim His existence! What does this mean for our lives and how we speak into the lives of others?
- 3. God designed humans to appreciate beauty. What things do you find beautiful and what do they tell you about the Artist?
- 4. We are 'fearfully and wonderfully made', but still we are *part* of creation. Read Psalm 148. The whole of creation praises God! How can we be part of this and protect it?

Together reread Psalm 148 aloud as an act of praise and worship.
